- A minor in Neuroscience (NRSC) consists of 15 hours of coursework.
- A grade of “C” or higher is required for a course to be counted in the minor field.
- No more than six (6) credit hours can be counted towards both the student’s major and the NRSC minor.
- Up to six (6) hours of directed studies (NRSC 485) and/or undergraduate research (NRSC 491) may be counted towards the minor. Hours cannot be counted towards both NRSC and an additional minor.
- The NRSC minor must be declared before the student has completed 95 credit hours.
